

## Life Drawing Studio

Who - NAA Members and nonmembers

What - Life Drawing Studio (non-instructional)

When - Third Thursday of each month, 9:00-11:00 a.m.  
June 21, July 19, August 16, 2018

Where - Brewery Arts Center Ballroom

Why - This is an opportunity to hone drawing skills from a live model to improve contours, shapes, light and shadows, and perspective.

Recommended timed sketches are:

Three 2-minute sketches

Two 10-minute sketches

Two 20-minute sketches

One 40-minute sketches

Ten minute break between 20 and 40 minute sketches

How - Non-instructional studio involves drawing from a nude live model. A time keeper will be present to announce times.

Cost is **cash only collected before each session** -

NAA Member - \$25/per Thursday session

Non-member - \$30/per Thursday session

Artists please arrive 20-30 minutes prior to set-up. Drawing begins promptly at 9:00 a.m.

Artists supply their own mediums such as charcoal, pencils, pastels, oil pastels which do not need extensive drying time. A backwash is acceptable if drying time is minimal. Drawing paper such as newsprint (18" x 24" or other) and other acceptable drawing paper is recommended.

Artists may bring their own easel, or easels (13 are available downstairs in the BAC art and ceramics room). Chairs are available upstairs near ballroom to use and return. Artists are responsible for carrying easels upstairs (two flights of 12 steps each) and returning them to art room. **An elevator is also available for transport.**

We recommend bringing an additional backboard (like thin Plexiglas, plywood, or stretched canvas the size of your paper) to place between the easel and your papers.

Bottled water or coffee/tea is allowed. There is a new and wonderful cafe downstairs.
